### Manuscript Categories & Guidelines

- **Research Articles (4,500 – 6,000 words):** Must present innovative, in-depth empirical research or critical theoretical findings. Submissions should strictly follow a structured progression: Abstract (100–150 words), Keywords (up to 5 arranged alphabetically), Introduction, Methodology/Material and Methods, Results and Discussion, and Conclusion.
- **Review Articles (6,500 – 7,000 words):** Expected to offer a comprehensive, systematic survey and critical synthesis of ongoing developments, paradigms, and literatures within a specific discipline. General 'textbook' or unstructured 'laundry list' styles must be strictly avoided.
- **Book Reviews (1,200 – 1,500 words):** Should provide an analytical, scholarly evaluation and contextualization of recent high-impact publications within the relevant social science fields.

### Manuscript Submission & Format Guidelines

1. **Typography and General Layout:** Manuscripts must be typewritten in *Times New Roman* (12 pt font size), double-spaced throughout (including block quotations, notes, and references), utilizing a standard 1-inch (25.4 mm) margin on all sides. All pages must be numbered sequentially from the title page onwards.
2. **Title Page & Anonymization:** To accommodate the blind peer-review process, authors must submit a separate title page containing the title, author names, institutional affiliations, and email

addresses. The main manuscript file must be fully anonymized, with no identifiers or explicit self-citations.

**3. Citations & References (Current APA Style):** In-text citations and the final bibliography must strictly follow the current APA Style standards (7th Edition). In-text citations must place the author's surname and the publication year inside parentheses separated by a comma (e.g., Smith, 2024). Every source cited in text must correspond to a verified entry in the alphabetical Reference list at the end of the document. Example journal reference: *Author, A. B., & Writer, C. D. (2024). Title of the journal article. Journal of Society in Kashmir, 14(1), 45–60. <https://doi.org/xxxx>*

**4. Tables and Figures:** All tables and figures must follow standard APA formatting, numbered consecutively using Arabic numerals (e.g., Table 1, Figure 1) following their order of appearance. A brief, clear, descriptive title must appear above each item, and comprehensive footnotes or credit lines for materials reproduced from other publications must be placed explicitly below.

**5. Compliance Portfolio:** Every submission must be accompanied by (a) a formal Cover Letter, (b) an official Institutional Plagiarism Check Report (showing less than 10% similarity index, excluding standard references), and (c) a signed Copyright Transfer Form. Manuscripts that fail to adhere to these structural formatting benchmarks will be summarily rejected without review.
