KU to introduce course on 'Sociology of Islam'

A one day workshop on framing curriculum for the proposed PG course 'Sociology of Islam' to be introduced in the Department of Sociology Kashmir University was organized on Saturday.

On the occasion, the acting Vice Chancellor, Prof. M A Sofi who presided over the inaugural event, said it is imperative to understand the sociology of Islam. "And for this, introduction of this course at the PG level is of vital importance," he said.
