Globalization and Identity Formation

- How global cultural flows (media, technology, consumerism) influence identity construction in Kashmir.
- The negotiation between global and local (glocalization) in shaping cultural practices and social identities.
- The impact of transnational Islamic movements and global religious trends on local religious practices.

Migration and Displacement

- Impact of migration on family structures, especially in rural areas.
- Migration patterns due to education, employment, and globalization

Identity, Ethnicity, and Nationalism

- Study of ethnic identities, religious diversity, and communal relations in a conflict-ridden society.
- The politics of identity in a region divided by geopolitical tensions.
- Nationalism, regionalism, and the shaping of collective identity in Kashmir.

Gender Studies
